One first cleanses the affected part with warm water and dries. Application of a few drops of OLBAS follows and



the skin is then firmly massaged. Then it is covered with woolen material. Relief is usually speedy. This applies to small local applications. The first sensation is of coolness, but this is followed by pleasant warmth. If perspiration is present, allow it to continue for an hour, then sponge quickly with warm water and wrap in a dry blanket.

Caution — Do not apply to irritated skin or if excessive irritation develops. Avoid getting into the eyes or on mucous membra-



nes. If pain persists for more than 10 days, or redness is present, or in conditions affecting children under 12 years of age consult a physician immediately.

For temporary relief of minor

Muscular Aches and Pains due to Fatigue and Exertion



one massages 5-10 or more drops of OLBAS on the aching and surrounding areas. The effect is greater if one washes first the skin with warm water and dries it, in order to open the pores. Or, one puts a few drops of OLBAS on a wet washcloth and washes for example tired, aching feet and leg muscles, moving repeatedly from the bottom upwards.

For temporary relief of

Pain of Simple Neuralgia

one rubs a few drops of OLBAS on the forehead, temple, and neck. If needed, a hot napkin is put on the neck after massaging it slowly.



Non-poisonous Insect Stings

A few drops of OLBAS are applied best immediately.

The active ingredients in OLBAS are: Oils of Peppermint, Eucalyptus, Cajuput, Juniper, Wintergreen, Menthol and Oil of Cloves. Nothing is added to these ingredients.

Gained by distillation from medicinal plants, the oils in OLBAS are called essential oils. (Wintergreen Oil is also known as Methyl Salicylate.) Although Menthol and Wintergreen Oil are widely produced synthetically today, the Menthol in OLBAS is derived from the Peppermint plant and the Wintergreen Oil in OLBAS is distilled from Winter-



green which latter plant is also called Gaultheria after the Canadian physician Dr. Gaultier.

OLBAS containers have to be kept tightly closed, since OLBAS is volatile. OLBAS should be stored in dark, cool places for maximum efficacy. Yet, OLBAS, in bottles, which were held for emergency cases in glove-compartments of cars, where it is — as being well known — very hot in summer, still helped par excellence when suddenly needed.

REMEMBER: OLBAS leaves no stains on linen. Increase or decrease dosage according to individual choice and experience!
